### What is Intellectual Property?

Intellectual property refers to creations of the mind, such as inventions, literary and artistic works, designs and symbols, names and images used in commerce.



## Copyright

A set of legal norms governing relations arising an **original literary, scientific and artistic work**. A work of art is created when the work is expressed in any objectively perceptible form.



- Personality rights cease to exist upon the author's death.
- Copyright protects your intellectual property until 70 years after your death, or 70 years after the death of the last surviving author in the case of a work of joint authorship



All rights reserved, this symbol may refer to works covered by copyright law, but copyright law does not require this. A work of art is created when the work is expressed in any objectively perceptible form.



### **Patents**

Patents are granted for inventions that are new, involve an inventive step and are susceptible of industrial application. Besides new products and technologies, chemical substances, pharmaceuticals and microorganisms used in industrial production, as well as biotechnological processes and products resulting from them can be patented.

Conditions for award:

- novelty,
- the result of creative inventive aktivity,
- industrial usability,





## **Utility models**

Utility model protection can be used for new technical solutions susceptible of industrial application, exceeding common technical skill. As stated above the conditions for utility model protection are different from the patent procedure in case of the inventive level.

As opposed to patents the registration of utility model can

be carried out quickly






### Patent search

Every R&D worker should start here. In order to solve the technical problem, it is necessary to carry out a patent search on the state of the art in the field. It should be extended to all relevant literature. You can do a patent search yourself using online databases (eg EPO, WIPO, EUIPO), or submit it to the UPV patent office or patent attorney.




## Paten application - Utility model application



Description of the invention, summary of the state of the art, disclosure of innovation, essence of the technical solution, introduction of at least one detailed embodiment




Claims determining the scope of patent protection

### **Employee invention**

Valid for Czech Republic

If the inventor creates an invention to fulfill his / her work duties, the right to the patent is transferred to the employer. If the employer fails to exercise the right to a patent within 3 months of the notification, the author himself may file an application for the invention. The originator is obliged to inform the employer about the invention without delay and to provide him with the necessary documents.

Legal regulations for employee invention vary according to the location where the employee invention originated.

## **Industrial designs**



Is intended for designer solutions. Industrial design is understood to mean appearance of a product or its part, consisting particularly of signs of lines, contours, colors, shape, material structure of the product per se or ornamentation. It involves a visually perceivable feature or component of a product.

Conditions for award:

- Individual,
- new,





### **Trademarks**

Trademark is a designation capable of graphical representation consisting especially of words, letters, numbers, colours, drawings or product shapes or packages, which serve to distinguish goods or services on the market.





Registered trademark symbol "Registered Trade Mark"






# Geographical denominations and appellations of origin

Appellation of origin is the name of a region, a specific place or a country (hereinafter referred to as region) used for goods originating in that region, whose quality or other characteristics are essentially or exclusively given by a particular geographical environment with its inherent natural and human factors and whose processing, production and preparation takes place in a delimited geographical region.


