## Fashion technical sketch

Standard Waist Band


Front view

Fly side is attached behind the closure with the zip being sewn in left side seam (side pattern pieces). Finished length is 2 cm above hipline.


Back view

Straight skirt is constructed of simple woven rectangles wrapped around the body. The skirt is gathered at the waist, the straight skirt uses darts to eliminate the fullness, thus creating a smoother line.
This slim-fitting garment can have a pleat or slit opening from the hem in the centre back for ease of movement.

## Measurements required

Body measurements:
(h) - Body height
(wg) - Waist girth
(hg) - Hip girth
(kI) - Length to knee
Garment measurements:
(skl) - Skirt length


The construction points are named according to their place on the body surface and according to the number of construction steps and they are marked by letters and numbers e.g.
