


#### SKIRT BLOCK PATTERN



#### **Fashion technical sketch**



**Straight skirt** is constructed of simple woven rectangles wrapped around the body. The skirt is gathered at the waist, the straight skirt uses darts to eliminate the fullness, thus creating a smoother line.

This slim-fitting garment can have a pleat or slit opening from the hem in the centre back for ease of movement.

(h) - Body height


(wg) - Waist girth


(hg) - Hip girth

(kl) - Length to knee

Garment measurements:

(skl) - Skirt length










The *construction points* are named according to their place on the body surface and according to the number of construction steps and they are marked by letters and numbers e.g.



-W21' - the balance point relates to point W21






# Correction of the lengths of dart legs











1 – Fabric Edge , 2 – Seam Line, 3 – Seam Allowance
